COLUMBIA, S.C. – The SCDC Office of Investigations and Intelligence released the arrest warrants today for a Summerville man on five charges involving a drone contraband attack on Lieber Correctional Institution.

Joshua Bryan Jordan, 29, was arrested and charged with operating a drone near an SCDC institution, providing contraband to a prisoner, criminal conspiracy, trafficking in cocaine and possession of marijuana.

The charges involve a drone that crashed into the yard at Lieber with a package of contraband containing 558 grams of marijuana, 585 grams of tobacco, four hacksaw blades and three lighters. Two of the charges involve substances believed to be cocaine and marijuana that were found in his possession when he was arrested.

The S.C. Department of Corrections reminds members of the public that after an arrest, the burden of proof is on the state to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt within a court of law.
