COLUMBIA, S.C. – The SCDC Inspector General released arrest warrants today for a program coordinator at Turbeville Correctional Institution.

Patrick Durelle Scott, 38, of Florence, is charged with providing prisoners with contraband and criminal conspiracy. The charges involve promise of a \$10,000 payment for delivery of tobacco, alcohol, cellphones, chargers and other items. He was fired after his arrest.

The S.C. Department of Corrections reminds members of the public that after an arrest, the burden of proof is on the state to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt within a court of law.
