COLUMBIA, S.C. – The SCDC Inspector General released arrest warrants today for two employees at Lee Correctional Institution.

Brian Darold Keely, 58, of Sumter, is charged with providing prisoners with contraband and criminal conspiracy. The charges against Keely, who was a food service supervisor at the prison, involve a large quantity of cellphones and narcotics found in his cafeteria office. During Tuesday's search, officers also found evidence of contraband deals with inmates on his cellphone. He was fired.

Brittany Nicole Welch, 33, of Rembert, is charged with misconduct in office and obstructing justice. The charges against Welch, a correctional officer at Lee, involve tipping inmates off to contraband searches, keeping weapons for inmates and allowing inmates to trade and share weapons. She was fired.

The arrests are part of a targeted investigation into employees at the Bishopville prison. Multiple other employees were suspended without pay, and the investigation continues.

"If you come to work at SCDC and have bad intent to bring in contraband to make money on the side, we're not going to put up with this conduct," SCDC Director Bryan Stirling said. "This is not just at Lee but across the state at all of our 21 prisons."

The S.C. Department of Corrections reminds members of the public that after an arrest, the burden of proof is on the state to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt within a court of law.

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT

I, Special Agent T. Sherbert, being duly sworn, do hereby depose and state:

I am a certified Law Enforcement Officer in the State of South Carolina. I am currently a Special Agent for the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC), Office of Inspector General (OIG). I am currently assigned to the OIG Major Crimes & Public Corruption Unit. I am authorized to conduct complex criminal investigations, conduct searches/seizures, and make arrests.

Misconduct in Office 17-25-0030 / CDR Code: 0819

PROBABLE CAUSE:

Special Agent T. Sherbert states the defendant, Brittany Nicole Welch, did commit the act of Misconduct in Office on or between the dates of August 06, 2023, and August 16, 2023, at Lee Correctional Institution, located at 990 Wisacky Hwy, in Lee County SC. Welch, a sworn SC Department of Corrections (SCDC) Lieutenant, who has been with employed with SCDC for approximately six years, did willfully commit the crime of Misconduct in Office. Lt. Welch did engage in misconduct in the form of malfeasance, misfeasance, and/or nonfeasance by committing acts in violation of her duty of good faith, honesty, and accountability of public trust as a State Corrections Officer to wit: On August 08, 2023, Lt. Welch provided SCDC inmate(s) with confidential information related to a pre-planned search of her assigned LeeCI unit, F-3, by the SCDC Agency Search Team (AST). This leaked confidential information did allow inmates to dispose of contraband weapons that would have otherwise resulted in their seizure and possible SCDC administrative and/or criminal charges against inmates if found in the inmate's possession by the AST. Lt. Welch took possession of the contraband weapons; however, knowing that such weapons are illegal and dangerous within SCDC by inmates, Lt. Welch failed to perform her lawful duty of reporting the seizure and/or turning in the items into evidence. The current whereabouts of the contraband weapons are unknown. On August 08, 2023, Lt. Welch did take possession of an electronic device that shared the physical characteristics of a cellphone from an inmate; however, knowing that the possession of such device is illegal and dangerous within SCDC by inmates, Lt. Welch failed to perform her lawful duty of reporting the seizure, charging the inmate and/or turning the device into evidence. The current whereabouts of the device are unknown. On August 08, 2023, after having knowledge of an institutional lockdown (no inmate movement) due to pre-planned searches by the AST, Lt. Welch knowingly and willfully allowed inmates to move in and

out of her assigned unit. Lt. Welch also knowingly and willfully allowed and assisted in the unauthorized transfer of a box containing unknown items between two inmates during the aforementioned institutional lockdown before the AST conducted a search of her assigned unit. On August 16, 2023, Lt. Welch failed to perform her lawful duties by leaving her assigned unit's wing doors unsecured which resulted in the transfer of contraband from one wing to another. On the same day, Lt. Welch witnessed an inmate going to a wing he was unauthorized to be in and she failed to perform her lawful duties by not stopping the inmate from being in an unauthorized area and this resulted in the transfer of suspected contraband from the inmate to another inmate.

I am a certified Law Enforcement Officer in the State of South Carolina. I am currently a Special Agent for the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC), Office of Inspector General (OIG). I am currently assigned to the OIG Major Crimes & Public Corruption Unit. I am authorized to conduct complex criminal investigations, conduct searches/seizures, and make arrests.

PROBABLE CAUSE:

Special Agent T. Sherbert states the defendant, Brittany Nicole Welch, did commit the act of Obstruction of Justice on or between the dates of August 08, 2023, and August 16, 2023, at Lee Correctional Institution, located at 990 Wisacky Hwy, in Lee County SC. Welch, a sworn SC Department of Corrections (SCDC) Lieutenant, who has been with employed with SCDC for approximately six years, did obstruct and/or otherwise impede the administration of justice to wit: On August 08, 2023, Lt. Welch provided SCDC inmate(s) with confidential information related to a preplanned search of her assigned LeeCI unit, F-3, by the SCDC Agency Search Team (AST). This leaked confidential information did allow inmates to dispose of contraband weapons that would have otherwise resulted in their seizure and possible SCDC administrative and/or criminal charges against inmates if found in the inmate's possession by the AST. Lt. Welch took possession of the contraband weapons; however, knowing that such weapons are illegal and dangerous within SCDC by inmates, Lt. Welch failed to perform her lawful duty of reporting the seizure and/or turning in the items into evidence. The current whereabouts of the contraband weapons are unknown. On August 08, 2023, Lt. Welch did take possession of an electronic device that shared the physical characteristics of a cellphone from an inmate; however, knowing that the possession of such device is illegal and dangerous within SCDC by inmates, Lt. Welch failed to perform her lawful duty of reporting the seizure, charging the inmate and/or turning the device into evidence. The current whereabouts of the device are unknown.
